The description of offices was printed in the February Grapevine. Here's a reminder:

PRESIDENT - shall preside at all meetings of YSDC and have in mind at all times the best interest of YSDC. The President shall call special meetings at the request of two thirds of the delegates. The President will automatically be an exofficio member of all committees.

VICE PRESIDENT - shall perform the duties of the President in the event of the President's absence.

SECRETARY - shall keep a record of all proceedings of YSDC, shall act as YSDC Correspondent in matters pertaining to the business of YSDC, and shall keep a correct enrollment of all member clubs.

TREASURER shall receive and take care of all monies belonging to YSDC and shall disburse it at the order of YSDC. The Treasurer shall keep an accurate report of all receipts and expenditures.

Silhouettes


